Libertarian Candidate Enters Race For Conewago Township Supervisor

Strinestown, PA— April 26, 2023 — This November, voters in Conewago Township in northern York County will have another option for Township Supervisor on their ballot. Long-time Conewago resident Timothy McMaster has announced his campaign for Supervisor in the upcoming race. Mr. McMaster has been the Libertarian candidate for the vacant state Senate seat (District 48) Special Election in 2021. He was also the Libertarian Party candidate for Lieutenant Governor in 2022.

McMaster is currently one of the elected auditors for the Township and has been twice elected as the chair of the Audit Board. “For far too long in Conewago Township, voters and taxpayers have been ignored by the Board of Supervisors,” says McMaster. “Every member is from the same party; the voters deserve a representative with fresh views.”

Mr. McMaster believes Conewago Township needs greater transparency from their supervisors. “Once elected, I plan to host separate Town Hall meetings to listen to the residents of our township. They need to be heard about what concerns they have and have their questions answered honestly. I’ll invite all the supervisors, but if they choose to avoid constituent questions, I’ll host them myself. I plan to bring accountability and transparency to local government.”
